38. The Picasso's WFTU mural

ABSTRACT: A drawing (mural in mosaic), by Pablo Picasso, dedicated to the WFTU is a patrimony of all the workers of the world who we must recover.

1. Introduction

In 1955, Pablo Picasso made a drawing dedicated to the X Anniversary of the WFTU. In 1979, S. Ballardin made it mosaic. The mural was placed in the host building of the WFTU in the Prague, exChecoeslovaquia.

2. Mural of the workers of the world

In 1978, in occasion of the IX World Trade Union Congress, the Czechoslovak unions donated to the WFTU a building, located in the historical central of Prague (Vinohraská 10, 12147, Praha 1), headquarters of the Federation.

To the fall of the European socialism, the conservative government took control of the WFTU's building. The mural of Picasso disappeared.

The FTE of Mexico proposed, in the 15° World Trade Union Congress, to develop an international campaign to recover the work

of Picasso. Unfortunately, there has been no echo. The FTE has made the search in galleries, museums and catalogues. The WFTU-Picasso's Mural does not appear.

3. Conclusions

The drawing (and mosaic) of Picasso, dedicated to the WFTU, are not patrimony deprived of anybody, are of the workers of the world
